- Failure to register by the presenting author will automatically imply that the abstract will neither be included in the final program or conference flash drive
- Final papers should not exceed 6000 words and must include an abstract of no more than 200 words, typed in double spacing, 12pt Times New Roman.
- The Harvard style of referencing should be used.
- Language editing of abstracts and final papers is compulsory.

Cape Peninsula University of Technology, **Granger Bay Campus**, Beach Road, Mouille Point, Cape Town, Western Cape, South Africa.

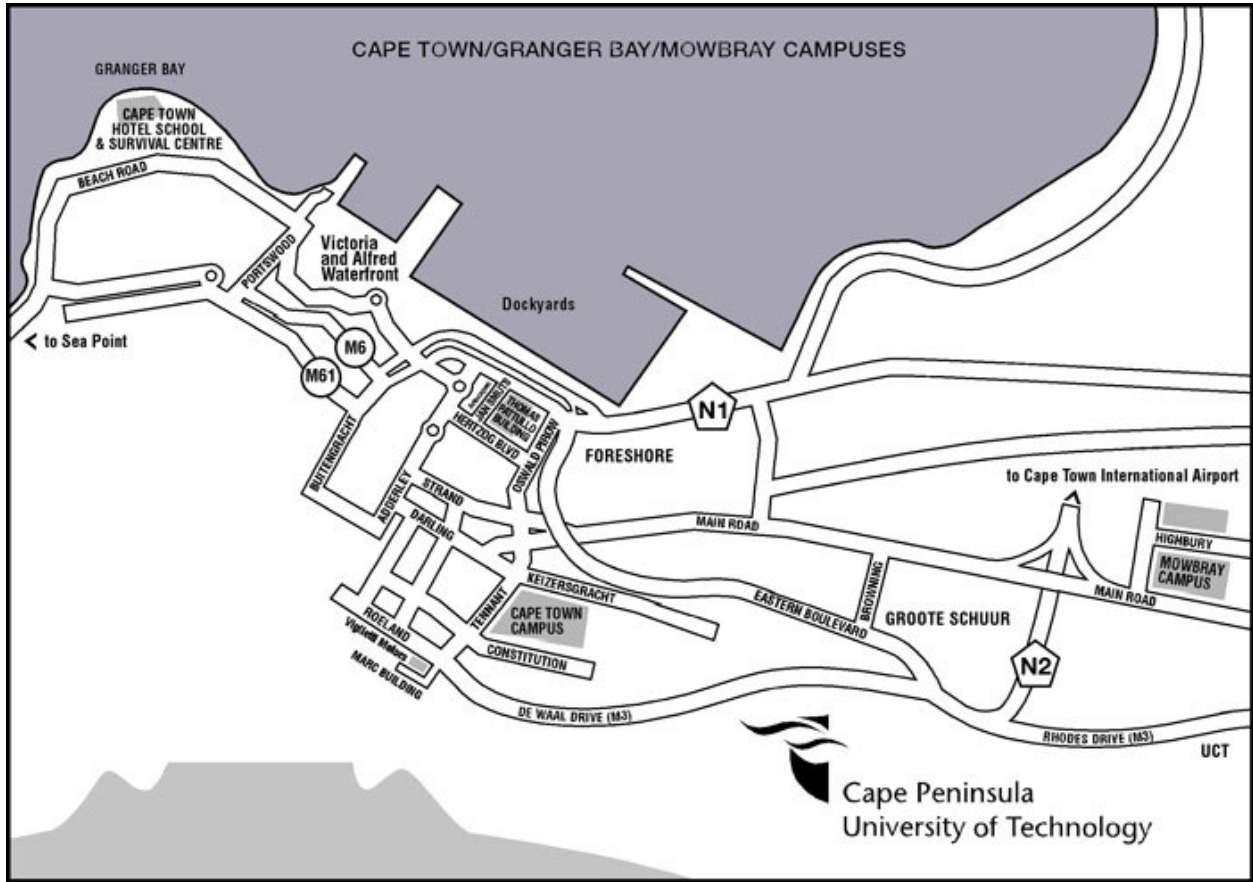
