Guidelines of submissions for posters

- Size: A2 (420 x 594 mm) or A1 (594 x 841 mm)
- Title should be short and interesting
- The word count should be about 300 to 800 words
- Use of bullets, numbering, and headlines make it easy to read
- Make effective use of graphics, color and fonts
- The Layout must be consistent and clean layout
- Must have acknowledgments, your name and institutional affiliation
- Poster digital layouts must be submitted to
