### **Mainstream Forum**

Articles of established authors are considered under this forum. Research points of mainstream publications may not exceed one DoHET research point per annum.

### **Emerging Researchers Forum**

Mainstream articles of novice authors (below the rank of Senior Lecturer) are considered under this forum. Research points of publications in the Emerging Researchers Forum may not exceed one DoHET research point per annum.

### **Postgraduate Forum**

This forum consists of combined manuscripts of supervisors and students resulting from completed master's and doctoral theses. Research points of publications in this forum may exceed more than one research point as it is a requirement at most universities that a publication must be submitted as part

### **International Non-Member Forum**

Articles of established international authors are considered under this forum. Research points of mainstream publications may not exceed one DoHET research point per annum. This forum promotes international articles *inter alia* to enhance the standing of the journal for accreditation with the DoHET and internationally; and to promote public administration, public management and public governance knowledge production and sharing globally.

### **Request to Serve as Referees**

In the spirit of academic collegiality all members are encouraged to serve as referees, and abide by the deadlines set for the return of referee reports, when called upon to do so.
